DAY 1 Tuesday 22 December

(Meal in-flight,D)    

Depart on **Air New Zealand** from **Brisbane International Airport** to **Norfolk Island Airport**. Upon arrival, we will be greeted with a **welcome to the historic island** and transferred to our hotel, checking in to **garden view rooms**. Tonight, we dress in convict outfits (provided) for a **'Night as a Convict'** and enjoy a fun-filled night of feasting, singing, dancing, laughter and convict mayhem!

DAY 2 Wednesday 23 December

(B,L,D)   

This morning we take an orientation tour of **Norfolk Island**, enjoying views of the beautiful scenery and hearing about the rich history and heritage of the island. Visit historic **Kingston, Cascade, Longridge, Emily Bay** and the **Melanesian Chapel**. Lunch will be enjoyed at **The Hilli Goat**, where we meet the cheeky goats and wander through the edible gardens then learn about the milking and cheese making process. Enjoy the rest of the afternoon at leisure. Lounge beside the hotel's lovely swimming pool, or just relax before dinner is served tonight at Cook's Landing Restaurant.

DAY 3 Thursday 24 December

(B,L,D)   

This morning we enjoy the **Convict Settlement tour** for an in-depth tour of the historic settlement of **Kingston**. Visiting the **cemetery**, we learn the history of convict and colonial headstones and stories of the houses along Quality Row. **Walk through the ruins** of the **New Gaol** and see the **Pier Store, Boat Shed** and **Crank Mill**. Our adventure this afternoon takes us on the Xtian Brothers **'Mootineers' cheese tour**. Visit a lovely boutique dairy and cheese producer, see beehives and learn about the production of local honey. Pass by the local sawmill then sample the cheese with tasty condiments and wine. Tonight, we watch the sun set from **Puppy's Point**, one of Norfolk's majestic clifftops on the beautiful western coastline, as we enjoy a **fish fry feast** of island dishes and some local entertainment.

DAY 4 Friday 25 December

(B,L,D)  

Merry Christmas! We meet for a festive breakfast together. Today is your day to relax and enjoy the facilities at the hotel as all venues are closed on Christmas Day. The highlight today is gathering for your **Christmas Day lunch** with all the trimmings, which will be one to remember! Enjoy a long lunch of **traditional and seafood fare**. A light dinner will be provided tonight.

DAY 5 Saturday 26 December

(B,L,D)  

Take some time out this morning to relax and enjoy your surroundings. After lunch at the hotel, we join the **Pitcairn Settlers Village tour** to one of the last remaining original settler's properties on the island, learning about the **Pitcairn settlement**, their history and culture. Tonight, dinner is served at the hotel.

DAY 6 Sunday 27 December

(B,L,D)  

After breakfast today we 'walk the plank' to board the **glass bottom boat cruise** (tide dependant) and discover Norfolk's lagoon marine life and coral gardens whilst cruising through the calm waters of **Emily Bay**. This afternoon we visit **Cyclorama**. Walk inside and feel like you are part of the continuous 360-degree panoramic painting scene. A spectacular 3D effect is achieved in detailed artwork. Storyboards explain the history of the mutineers and their arrival in Norfolk. Discover **Norfolk's rich artistic community** whilst browsing the gallery. Tonight, dinner is at the hotel.

Today the group will alternate, to join the Island Adventures **4WD tour**, taking us through private properties featuring spectacular scenery, native flora and abundant birdlife. Touring through **Norfolk's National Park**, we see the different stages of the **Norfolk Pine**. Time at leisure to explore the island at your own pace this afternoon or rest for tonight's event. Non-Australian citizens are required to seek independent advice regarding passport validity and entry visa, and ensure all is correct prior to travel to Norfolk Island.

International terms and conditions apply to Norfolk Island tours, requiring balance of payment for this tour 100 days prior to departure and at this time 100% cancellation fees apply.

Travel insurance is compulsory and it is recommended that it be purchased at time of paying deposit. Tour passengers will require a clearance letter (provided by Fun Over Fifty) from their local GP for travel.
